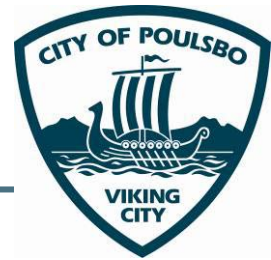

**Partial Road Closure:** 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue/Bjermeland/Moe Street

(Poulsbo, WA) – The New City Hall project is on track for the target move-in date of September 2010, and you can see progress being made daily at 3<sup>rd</sup> and Moe Street, downtown Poulsbo. As part of the project, the city is planning road improvements to the surrounding streets, including 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Bjermeland, and Moe Street.

Construction crews will begin rebuilding portions of these streets on March 15<sup>th</sup>. Citizens can expect delays for about two weeks, and are encouraged to travel alternate routes. The first layer of asphalt will be laid during these two weeks, and the second layer and finish coat will be completed with road striping the first couple weeks of May.

During the month of March, there will be some drastic changes to the new city hall project. We'll see windows installed, drying the inside, and will see the start of the stucco, brick, and wood siding around the building. Inside, the walls will be insulated and drywall will go up, along with the installation of the building elevator.
