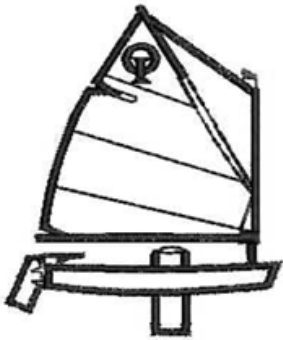

## North Kitsap Summer Sailing Camps

**P&R Staff.** Sailing lessons will be offered again this summer for **ages 8-18**. Camps will be held at the Port of Kingston next to the boat ramp. There will be 4 all-day camps for students 11 and older using a variety of boats, and this season, we will offer morning and afternoon camps in the Opti boats for 8- to 12-year-old sailors.

**Students must have beginner swimming skills and provide their own Coast Guard-approved life jackets.** The all-day classes will be conducted in Byte class sailboats, a 12-foot, self-righting dinghy that was developed especially for junior training; and four Laser class dinghies. The Opti is used for our younger sailors, and is a more stable design for our younger sailors, although it performs very well in a breeze. Opti class sailboats have been used around the world for many years as a junior trainer.



The purpose of our sailing camps is to learn sailing skills, boating safety, and to have fun! Please remember, however, that sailing can at times be dangerous and students must be willing to work hard each day. Capsizing for the "fun" of it will not be tolerated. **A Coast Guard-approved life jacket must be worn at all times when on the dock and in the water.**

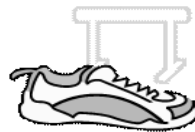
